



MISSION






ADMISSION & WITHDRAWAL

Those seeking admission in Nursery should be within the age group as per the NEP 2020, of the year of admission. The admission to other classes depends on vacancies. information of which will be available in the school office. Since the school is affiliated to CBSE, students of Chavara Kids Garden will be promoted to class I from KG section. Students coming from other Pre-Primary school may find it difficult to cope up with the curriculum and methodology of the school.

> For withdrawal of a student from the school a calendar Month's notice must be given in writing otherwise a calendar month's fee will be charged. All the dues must be cleared before issuing




The merit of the student is the only criterion for selection. The school does not charge capitation fee. Recommendations will not be entertained.

The principal reserves to himself the right to refuse admission to any student without furnishing any reason.






















- 3. Every student is required to get a qualifying grade D or above in all the subjects for the purpose of promotion to the next class.
- 4. A student getting E1 or E2 grade in scholastic areas in one or more subjects will have to improve his/her performance in one subsequent attempt to obtain qualifying grade D in these subjects.
- 5. Unsatisfactory progress in studies, insufficient attendance, misbehaviour or unfair Means during the examination or tests may keep a student debarred from the examination followed by disciplinary action.
- 6. To access the performance of their wards after tests and examinations, a progress report card will be given to the parents after the Annual Examination.
- 7. The result of the Annual Examination will be declared, only after the student has cleared all the dues to the school.
